Dear Reverend, Pastors and Ministers,

A Call for a Solemn Assembly for our nation, for Such a Time As This

Shalom! Ever since April 2014, after the disappearance of MH 370 and the combined drought and haze in the early quarters of 2014, the AG Prayer Commission (AGPC) has been calling for Solemn Assemblies (Joel 1:14, 2:15-16) during the 21 Day Fast & Prayer in the period of Lent.

As taught by Rev. Julius Suubi & others, there is a **cup of iniquity** that is being measured for every nation (Gen 15:16, Matt 23:32, Rev 17:4). Each time we repent corporately, as well as individually, a portion of that cup is emptied, averting the cup of wrath and judgement of God upon our land (Jonah 3:5-9, Isa 50:2f, Rev 16:19).

This year **the call is even more urgent**, with the GE 14, touted mother of all elections, around the corner and the resulting mudslinging that has begun from all quarters.

How will the Solemn Assembly be held?

As per the previous years, we encourage everyone to be involved. Your church can either...

- 1) hold the Solemn Assembly individually with your own members OR
- 2) join with a few other churches to hold a combined Solemn Assembly.

Date : **March 17, 2018 (Saturday)** or any date close to this date, chosen by your church. This is during the period of Lent and is a good time to remember our Lord's precious sacrifice for us. It is also the first Saturday of our 21 Day Fast & Prayer (March 11-31, 2018) with Resurrection Sunday on April 1, 2018.
