## A PRAYER WALK / DRIVE

A prayer walk or a prayer drive is a journey you take with a small group of people to hear God's heart about a particular location or area. It is a low-risk, highly informative means of connecting with God's heart for your communities and neighborhoods.

### TYPES OF PRAYER WALK / DRIVE

#### 1. During the normal business of life

Prayer walking, being a way to redeeming time, can add divine

significance to some of our regular daily activities. For example:

- a. Walk to and from the bus-stops / MRT Station.
- b. When we walk the dog, if applicable.
- c. When we are in the checkout queue at the supermarket or any waiting situation.
- d. Prayer walk the corridors of your block of flats.
- e. Try to spend half an hour prayer walking the neighborhood and praying for every house once a week.
- f. When on holiday, pray with your companion as you walk around the sights.

g. Take an evening stroll with your spouse or a friend instead of watching the TV.

## 2. Planned Cell Group Activity

Prayer walking / Prayer driving is ideal for cell groups.

## 3. Church-Wide Walks

Leaders can organise a whole church prayer invasion of an area. The aim is to mobilise every member on one evening or afternoon to pray for a neighbourhood. Such united exercises can be done city-wide. Usually, we set aside a time and drive around.

- a. Preparation, Planning & Going Out
1. Plan a route round your region/town/city. You can focus on the 7 mountains of society namely Arts & Entertainment (landmarks/historic places), Business (shopping centre/shops/restaurants), Education (schools/colleges/Uni), Family (housing areas), Govt., Media and Religion (places of worship).
  2. Meet at a church premise and have a short time of praise & worship. Then explain what you are going to do. Hand out the maps and prayer points and brief everyone about the route, and your suggested places for stopping and praying & mark with "x"s some prayer stations where

people can stop and pray. Also prepare a list of prayer points for these places. For example, "At the council offices stop and pray for your local councillors, for wise decision making and godly leadership".

3. It is a good idea to begin your prayer drive with a worship song and/or a Psalm of praise (or other Scripture the Lord may bring to mind). Assign someone to serve as a scribe to write down any observations, revelation, or verses the Holy Spirit brings to your attention.
4. Ask Him to show you areas of need in your community and how you might bless those areas of need in prayer. Explain that prayer can be

out loud, although it's also OK for prayer to be in silent as well. There may be some in group who are more comfortable with this, especially in public spaces.

5. Pray! Pray before you go - for discernment, protection, and inspiration in prayer. Pray that God would reveal things to you as you are walking around your town and in amongst its people.
6. Pray words of life, encouragement, and redemption over what you see. Inspire people to pray by looking at an appropriate scripture or reading this quote from Watchman Nee:-  
*" Our prayers lay the track down which God's power can come. Like a*

*mighty locomotive, his power is irresistible, but it cannot reach us without rails."*

7. Invite the Lord to reveal any spiritual roots that are hindering Kingdom growth in specific parts of your community: occultism, extreme poverty, overt material wealth, etc.
8. When your prayer drive is over, begin asking the Lord as a team what He would have you do in terms of follow-up. He may direct you to develop an outreach at a specific place, or He may lead you to continue to drive and pray.
