DAY 1 (11 May 2026)

Advancing the Kingdom Through Evangelism

Matthew 28:19–20 (NKJV)

¹⁹ Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age.” Amen.

Devotion

The kingdom of God is the rule of God over the universe. Psalms 103:19 says, “The Lord has established His throne in heaven, and His kingdom rules overall.” Make no mistake that our God is all-powerful and yet, rather than exerting His control over peoples, He invites them to be a part of His kingdom. A pivotal message of Jesus is, “Repent for the kingdom of God is at hand.”

In His final instruction, Jesus said to the disciples that He has all authority in heaven and on earth and He wants His disciple to evangelise – to spread the gospel to all peoples and invite nations to become His disciples. And signs and wonders will accompany the evangelistic work to advance the kingdom of God on earth.

The kingdom of God and evangelism are inseparable. The kingdom of God is the central message of Christ, and evangelism is the means to draw people into God's reign through Christ. Coupled with discipleship, advancing the kingdom through evangelism open peoples' eyes, and turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God.

As citizens of the kingdom of God, it is the responsibility for all Christians to evangelise. "Accelerate 30" vision to cultivate and elevate evangelists to serve and impact churches is one of the strategies of our movement to fulfil the Great Commission.

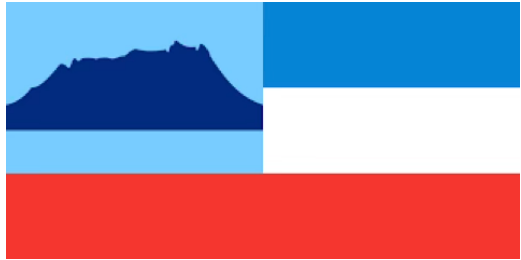
Prayer Points:

 - *Pray for the church to responsibly do the work of evangelism.*
 - *Pray for the Accelerate 30 vision's initiative to cultivate and elevate evangelists to succeed. There will be platform for them to serve and impact churches.*
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Pray for the State of Sabah

Psalm 24:9

Lift up your heads, O you gates! And be lifted up, you everlasting doors! And the King of glory shall come in.



Sabah is known as 'Land Below the Wind'. It is a land with vast resources, a land with significant Christian populations among indigenous Kadazan-Dusun, Murut, and Rungus communities.

- *Pray that pastors and spiritual leaders will unite and contend as one. There will be healing of all fractures in the churches and across denominations. Pray that traditional walls among denominations be demolished.*
- *Pray for unity among the 32 different indigenous groups. Pray for leaders to arise and assume their roles with authority and mutual cooperation. The churches and leaders to arise and take ownership of their destiny, for fresh anointing of courage and boldness.*

- *Pray for border security and protection against threats of infiltration from illegal entry of foreigners, terrorists, smuggling activities, bribery and corruption of border officials. Solutions for stateless children. There will be economic development through sustainable industries - agriculture, eco-tourism, fishing.*

DAY 2 (12 May 2026)

Advancing the Kingdom Through the Church

Matthew 16:16-19 (NKJV)

¹⁶ Simon Peter answered and said, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."

¹⁷ Jesus answered and said to him, "Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah, for flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but My Father who is in heaven. ¹⁸ And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it. ¹⁹ And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven."

Devotion

"I will build My church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it," is a powerful promise by Jesus, assuring those who follow Him shall triumph over the power of hell.

The Lord followed up on the promise with another promise: "I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven," which means that the church has access to the kingdom of God and will be His physical representation on earth with full authority.

The church is an important part of the kingdom of God because it is the primary agency to manifest and advance God's redemptive work. Jesus loves His church. He prays for His church. And He will come back for His church. All of these and much more signify the power and the glory of the church through Christ (see Ephesians 3:20-21).

As the kingdom of God advances, the church advances. A crucial area to show the advancement made by the church is the multiplying of churches. Where darkness is present, the church must be there to light up the place. To do so, planting new churches to expand our reach and impact is a strategy to show the triumphant powers of the kingdom of God. In fact, every church is a powerful manifestation of the kingdom of God on earth.

Prayer Points:

- *Pray for the church to manifest the power and glory of Christ on earth.*
- *Pray for the church to multiply through planting new churches.*
- *Pray for the Accelerate 30 vision's initiative to plant new churches to succeed. There will be a wave of new church plants, expanding our impact.*

Pray for the State of Melaka

Psalm 33:8-11

"⁸ Let all the earth fear the Lord; let all the people of the world revere Him. ⁹ For He spoke, and it came to be; He commanded, and it stood firm. ¹⁰ The Lord foils the plans of the nations; He thwarts the purposes of the peoples. ¹¹ But the plans of the Lord stand firm forever, the purposes of His heart through all generations."



Melaka is the location of one of the earliest Malay Sultanate. Malacca city has been listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It is noted for its unique history and is one of the major tourist destinations in Malaysia.

- *Pray that the Lord will watch over this gateway, that it will always stay open to the King of Glory. Melaka's heritage is a Gateway City for the gospel to come to our nation. Francis Xavier was the first missionary to bring the gospel to Melaka in 1545. The first Protestant Bible into Mandarin, both Old and New Testament was first printed in 1823 in Melaka.*
- *Pray for the churches in Melaka to be raised up and united, that they can be given the keys of the kingdom to unlock the destiny of this city. The foundations of the church of God in Melaka were laid down even before our nation was formed*
- *Pray that God will raise up more church pastors, leaders, politicians, civil society leaders, civil servants, business and marketplace people who have a genuine concern for the welfare of the city.*

DAY 3 (13 May 2026)

Advancing the Kingdom Through Prayer & Intercession

Matthew 6:9-10 (NKJV)

⁹ *In this manner, therefore, pray: Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name.*

¹⁰ *Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.*

Devotion

Jesus said, "This, then, is how you should pray: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven . . ."

Advancing the kingdom through prayer and intercession is partnering with God, primarily to bring His will to earth. It is praying for the establishment of God's reign in anticipation of the rule of Christ on His return. It is also praying for the fulfilment of God's destiny for the church. The outcome of prayer is the application of the standards of heaven on the earth.

Acts 1:8 states how the kingdom of God advances: "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." The Holy Spirit empowers and emboldens believers to carry God's will on earth through effective witnessing. Is it any wonder that the Lord told His disciples to "pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out labourers into His harvest field". Ask God to raise up and send witnesses into the world.

Remember, the kingdom of God has come with the arrival of the Holy Spirit. Prayer and intercession accelerate the advancement of the kingdom of God through powerful witnessing.

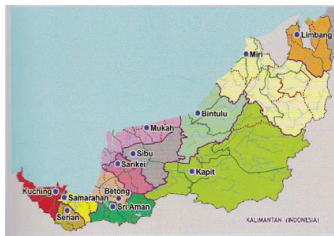
Prayer Points:

- *Pray for a prayer and intercession anointing on the church.*
- *Pray for a powerful witnessing anointing on the church.*
- *Pray for the Accelerate 30's initiative to energise churches to succeed. Each church will fulfil their mission with renewed vigour.*

Pray for the State of Sarawak

Genesis 17:7

And I will establish My covenant between Me and you and your descendants after you in their generations, for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and your descendants after you.



Sarawak, the largest state in Malaysia, is also known as 'the Land of Hornbills'. 50.1% (2020) of the population are Christians comprising of mainly Iban, Chinese, Bidayuh and other bumiputera.

- Pray for the broken covenant of all constitutional rights (original terms and conditions) of 1963 Malaysia Agreement (MA 63) to be restored, honoured and upheld for East Malaysia.*
- Pray for committed intercessors and watchmen to anchor the prayer mountains at Bakelalan and Mt Murud as well prayer houses in this state.*

- *Pray for revival among the younger generation of natives who have become nominal – for a return to their first love and passionate hearts to hunger and seek for encounters to meet His Holy Presence & Power in their lives.*

DAY 4 (14 May 2026)

Advancing the Kingdom Through Pentecost

Acts 2:1-4 (NKJV)

2 When the Day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. ² And suddenly there came a sound from heaven, as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. ³ Then there appeared to them divided tongues, as of fire, and one sat upon each of them. ⁴ And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Devotion

Soon we shall celebrate Pentecost Sunday. Prior to Pentecost, Jesus commanded the disciples not to leave Jerusalem until God sent them the gift He promised, which was the baptism of the Holy Spirit. Pentecost took place ten days after the ascension of Christ. The number ten symbolizes completeness, which means the Holy Spirit's arrival completes the salvation plan for the birth of the church.

The baptism of the Spirit is to empower believers to fulfil the Great Commission and advance the kingdom of God on earth. The infilling of the Spirit is after salvation and the evidence is the gift of tongues, which is also known as the “second blessing.” Acts 2:4 says, “All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.”

Apart from the gift of tongues, the Holy Spirit also bestows various spiritual gifts to empower believers, such as wisdom, knowledge, faith, healing, miracles, prophecy, discernment, tongues, and interpretation (1 Corinthians 12).

Pentecost marks the dispensation of the Holy Spirit whereby God’s Spirit is actively working in and around the church. The “tongues of fire,” “the mighty rushing wind” and “speak in other tongues” were manifestations of the active presence of the Holy Spirit. As Pentecostals, we identify with these distinctives and eagerly look forward to celebrate Pentecost

Prayer Points:

- *Pray for the church to seek the baptism of the Spirit with the gift of tongues.*
- *Pray for the church to seek the spiritual gifts of the Spirit to advance God’s kingdom.*

- *Pray for the success of Accelerate 30 vision. There will be the elevation of our identity as Pentecostals. The Assemblies of God of Malaysia will be a Spirit empowered movement with a vibrant community of the Word, Spirit, Power and Missions.*
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Pray for the State of Terengganu

Lamentations 2:18-19

*¹⁸ Their heart cried out to the Lord,
"O wall of the daughter of Zion,
Let tears run down like a river day and night;
Give yourself no relief;
Give your eyes no rest.*

*¹⁹ "Arise, cry out in the night,
At the beginning of the watches;
Pour out your heart like water before the face of the
Lord.*

*Lift your hands toward Him
For the life of your young children,
Who faint from hunger at the head of every street."*



Terengganu Darul-Iman means Abode of Faith. Terengganu was the first Malay state to embrace Islam, as evidenced by the Terengganu Inscribed Stone (Batu Bersurat) in Arabic found at Kuala Berang. This state is ruled by Sharia Law which only applies to Muslims.

- *Pray for God's sovereign rule over the state, nullifying the works of darkness of black magic, idol worshipping, strongholds of fraudulent conversion, cult (e.g. Jehovah Witness) and false religious teaching. Drug addiction, drug trafficking, HIV, LGBT, incest, divorce rate, poverty, school drop-out, illegal logging and bribery are social and economic problems of the state. Pray for effective ways to combat these social ills and economic problems.*
- *Pray for revival in the state economic situation when ECRL is completed so that Next Gen of young people who had left Terengganu can return.*
- *Pray for succession plan for younger full-time workers and pastors to take over the elderly church leadership.*

DAY 5 (15 May 2026)

Advancing the Kingdom Through the Supernatural

Matthew 10:1, 7-8 (NKJV)

¹And when He had called His twelve disciples to Him, He gave them power over unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease. ⁷And as you go, preach, saying, 'The kingdom of heaven is at hand.' ⁸Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give.

Devotion

The supernatural are events beyond scientific understanding. To advance the kingdom of God through the supernatural means to have the power to move beyond the natural, the physical or the ordinary. It is moving in the realm of the spirit empowered by Holy Spirit.

Jesus' ministry showed the supernatural at work through the feeding of the five thousand, the walking on water, the raising of Jarius' daughter and more. The resurrection of Christ is the greatest demonstration of the supernatural power of God.

The early church's explosive growth could be traced to acts of the apostle in the supernatural, for example, Peter and John healed the disabled man from birth, Peter raised Dorcas to life, Peter rescued by an angel, and more. Indeed, supernatural acts of healing, signs, wonders, and conversions often followed the early disciples' powerful Spirit-led messages.

The modern church would be wise to follow the example of the apostolic church to move in the supernatural. This requires disciplines like prayer and fasting, moving in the gifts of the Spirit, stepping into the arena of spiritual warfare, and more.

Jesus said, "since the time of John the Baptist until now, the kingdom of heaven has been forcefully advancing. . . meaning the kingdom is a powerful movement that demand strong responses. As such, moving in the supernatural is the revolution that need to happen in the modern church.

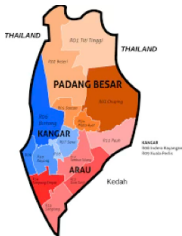
Prayer Points:

- *Pray for the church to preach the gospel with signs, wonder and miracles.*
- *Pray for the church to engage in spiritual warfare forcefully.*
- *Pray for the church to reclaim its apostolic mantle by moving in the supernatural.*

Pray for the State of Perlis

Deuteronomy 3:5

"All these cities were fortified with high walls, gates, and bars, besides a great many rural towns.



Perlis is known as Perlis Indera Kayangan or the Northern Gem. It is situated on the northwestern coast of Peninsular Malaysia and is the smallest state in Malaysia in area and in population. In 2015, 139 mass graves of people believed to be Rohingyas from Myanmar and Bangladesh (victims of human trafficking) and 29 illegal detention camps were discovered in jungles north Wang Kelian in an area called Wang Burma. The Royal Commission of Inquiry (RCI) report found "gross negligence on the part of border patrols, adding that the flip-flop nature of government policies concerning migrant workers caused illegal syndicates to operate freely".

Terengganu Darul-Iman means Abode of Faith. Terengganu was the first Malay state to embrace Islam, as evidenced by the Terengganu Inscribed Stone (Batu Bersurat) in Arabic found at Kuala Berang. This state is ruled by Sharia Law which only applies to Muslims.

- *Pray for repentance of bloodguilt over the land from bloodshed of these innocent victims of human trafficking. Pray for a greater strengthening of security along the northern border by the relevant authorities.*
- *Pray for wisdom for the state authorities to eradicate drug addiction and curb all forms of crime in the state.*
- *Pray for unity of the churches - to be strengthened, equipped and walking in the ministry of reconciliation, pastors and leaders to come together in corporate prayers.*

DAY 6 (16 May 2026)

The Land and Covenantal Responsibility

Psalm 24:1

The earth and everything in it, the world and its inhabitants, belong to the Lord.

Job 41:11

*Who confronted Me, that I should repay him?
Everything under heaven belongs to Me.*

Psalm 37:29

The righteous will inherit the land and dwell in it permanently.

Proverbs 2:21

For the upright will inhabit the land, and those of integrity will remain in it;

Devotion

Throughout ages, man has been fighting over land to own it because land is not just soil. It symbolises power and carries prophetic and spiritual significance as well.

Scripture tells us that God is the Divine Owner of the whole earth and He charged mankind through Adam to manage His land well (Genesis 1:28-30). This means we are tenants of the piece of land where we dwell or 'own'.

However, the land became cursed when sin entered into the world through Adam and Eve (Genesis 3:17-19). Satan and the spirits of darkness then gained spiritual legal right and stewardship over the land through the continual evil acts of mankind. When the land becomes polluted with sin, injustice, idolatry or bloodshed, it cries out for redemption.

As the Divine Owner of the land, God wants to heal it as He proclaimed in 2Chronicles 7:14 "if My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land".

Notice that it is God who heals the land but we are the ones given the responsibility to initiate the healing through humility, prayer, seeking God's face and turning from our wicked ways.

God in His divine plan of redemption has sent Jesus Christ to redeem the world of sin and unrighteousness, and this also affects the physical land (Romans 8:19-23) too. In other words, it is our covenant responsibility to reclaim spiritual stewardship of the land from Satan through the power of the cross and the blood of Jesus Christ. Hebrews 7:12 says, "For when there is a change in the priesthood, there is necessarily a change in the law as well". ESV



So how then do we redeem the land? By rising up and taking our positions as priests, raising up prayer altars before Him, and by faith advancing together to reclaim what the enemy has stolen. God has promised us victory in Deuteronomy 7:22-23,

²² But He will drive out these nations ahead of you only little by little. You won't be able to finish them off all at once because if you did, the wild animals would reproduce rapidly in the empty land and that would be dangerous. ²³ But the Eternal your God definitely will defeat these nations in front of you. He will throw them into a great panic until they are all destroyed.

Prayer Points:

- *Acknowledge that God is the true owner of the world earth and we are "tenants" of the land where we live in. Pray that we will be responsible stewards of God's purposes and plans for His land.*
- *Pray for God to help us build an ecosystem of prayer in our families, the church and marketplace so that Hebrews 7:12 will take effect in our land.*
- *Pray for God to raise up mature and responsible disciples who will stand in the gap for the nation (Ezekiel 22:30).*

Pray for the State of Perak

Isaiah 32:15-18

*“¹⁵ till the Spirit is poured on us from on high,
and the desert becomes a fertile field,
and the fertile field seems like a forest.*

*¹⁶ The Lord’s justice will dwell in the desert,
his righteousness live in the fertile field.*

*¹⁷ The fruit of that righteousness will be peace;
its effect will be quietness and confidence forever.*

*¹⁸ My people will live in peaceful dwelling places,
in secure homes, in undisturbed places of rest.”*



Perak Darul Ridzuan means Abode of Grace. It was renowned for its rich tin mines in the past. Today, Perak has become a harmonious and multi racial society with a rich heritage characterised by its diversity in language and culture.



- *Pray for cleansing of the land of Perak from all defilement through idolatry, immorality / fornication, bloodshed and broken covenants.*
- *Pray for a Joshua generation to arise to be resilient in the Lord till they experience breakthroughs against the stronghold of animism, poverty and apathy.*
- *Pray for the success of succession plans from the present to a younger generation of leaders in churches.*



DAY 7 (17 May 2026)

Spiritual Actions That Redeem the Land

Leviticus 26:3-4

"If you follow My decrees and are careful to obey My commands, I will send you the seasonal rains. The land will then yield its crops, and the trees of the field will produce their fruit."

Devotion

Throughout Scripture, we see that land can be blessed or cursed depending on the spiritual state of its inhabitants. God cried out that His land is defiled by iniquity and sin. (See Jeremiah 16:17-18). Some signs of a spiritually defiled land are:

- *Unrest, conflict, or disharmony within families and communities.*
- *Unusual financial struggles or business failure in a specific location.*
- *Persistent crime, violence, or bloodshed.*
- *Ancestral or generational curses linked to the land's history.*
- *Recurring natural disasters or environmental distress.*
- *Broken covenants*

Remember we are not fighting against flesh and blood but against the principalities and powers of darkness. (Ephesians 6:12). The land can be healed, restored and be blessed again through earnest repentance, prayer and sanctification. It's time to stand in repentance, cleanse the land through prayer, and ask God to restore His blessing. We can begin by consistently doing the following:

- *Repenting: Acknowledging and confessing sins that may have defiled the land.*
 - *Worshipping: Building altars of thanksgiving and praise to invite God's presence and blessings back to the land.*
 - *Prophesying: Declaring God's ownership and purposes over the land through prophetic prayers.*
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Prayer Points:

- *Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal the root cause of the defilement (territorial sins) of the land (it maybe your residential area or town or nation).*
- *Pray this prayer of cleansing and repentance.*

Heavenly Father, I come before You to repent for every sin, bloodshed, idolatry, and wickedness that has defiled this land. I acknowledge that sin opens doors for curses, and I stand in the gap to ask for Your mercy and cleansing.

Leviticus 18:25 (NLT) "Because the entire land has become defiled, I am punishing the people who live there. I will cause the land to vomit them out."

Lord, forgive the sins of those who lived here before me —every act of injustice, broken covenants, occult practices, and ungodly rituals. I renounce every evil altar raised on this land and command them to be destroyed by fire in Jesus' name!

2 Chronicles 7:14 (NLT) "Then if my people who are called by my name will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sins and restore their land."

I plead the blood of Jesus over this land, covering it with divine purification. Let every curse be broken, and let this land be restored to fruitfulness, prosperity, and divine protection.

Father, I dedicate this land back to You. Let it become a place of blessing, peace, and divine habitation. Let Your Spirit dwell here, and let everything that has been stolen be restored!

In Jesus' mighty name, Amen.

Pray for the State of Pahang

Proverbs 13:23

"A poor man's field may produce abundant food, but injustice sweeps it away."



Pahang Darul Makmur means Abode of Tranquility. Modern Pahang is an economically important state with major activities in the services, manufacturing and agriculture sectors. The demand for high-value durians has unfortunately led to deforestation and illegal farming. This encroachment caused a loss of access for the Orang Asli (Negrito, Senoi and Proto Malay) to the forest and land resulting in an erosion of their economic self-reliance. They are the bumiputras and yet so much has been taken away from them.

- *Pray for justice to be meted out for the loss of their native lands and for wisdom for the OA communities to cope with their changing environment- that their lands will be restored or compensated and for local state government to grant necessary aid and infrastructure for improved living conditions, that they able to get work despite their limited education and skills.*
- *Pray for the Salvation of the lost – those living in the urban, in the rural and in the jungles. Many will be convicted of sin, righteousness and judgment.*
- *Pray for churches to raise up watchmen and intercessors for Pahang and for God's protection from the schemes of the enemy and internal/external negative influences.*



DAY 8 (18 May 2026)

Redeeming the Land through Worship

Genesis 12:7 AMP

Then the Lord appeared to Abram and said, "I will give this land to your descendants." So, Abram built an altar there to [honour] the Lord who had appeared to him.

Devotion

It's interesting to note that Abraham's response to God's promise of a land is to build God an altar of worship. Here, Abraham acknowledged that God is the owner of the land and he thanked God for the honour of being entrusted the responsibility of stewarding the land. His journey of faith to claim the land began with a lifestyle of worshipping the true God.

A defiled land brings forth curses and influences those who live therein. Evil altars (unholy worship) in the land open doors to demonic forces and only God's light can dispel it. Worship is a powerful weapon in spiritual warfare because when we worship God in spirit and in truth, He will do the fighting for us (see 2 Chronicles 20) - the atmosphere shifts; doors open; blessings multiply.



Worship is more than singing; it is the posture of a surrendered heart exalting the God of heaven and earth. True worship will bring a shift in the spirit realm, opening the heavenly portals and dispelling the darkness over the land. When God sits enthroned on the praises of His people (Psalm 22:3) the land is redeemed from curses and will flourish again.

¹² You will live in joy and peace. The mountains and hills, the trees of the field—all the world around you—will rejoice. ¹³ Where once were thorns, fir trees will grow; where briars grew, the myrtle trees will sprout up. This miracle will make the Lord's name very great and be an everlasting sign of God's power and love. Isaiah 55:12–13 LB

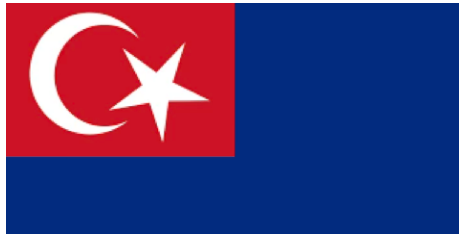
Prayer Points:

- *Pray for every Christian to experience true worship that brings transformation. Romans 12:1*
- *Pray for every family to worship the Lord together, building family altars.*
- *Pray for the Church to return to her first love, rebuilding altars of worship and covenantal faithfulness unto the Lord.*

Pray for the State of Johor

Isaiah 61:1

"The Spirit of the Lord God is upon Me, Because the Lord has anointed Me To preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives, And the opening of the prison to those who are bound."



Darul Ta'zim means Abode of Dignity. Johor derives its name from Jauhar meaning precious stones. Johor is one of Malaysia's most important economic hubs, having the highest gross domestic product (GDP) in Malaysia outside of the Klang Valley, making it the country's second largest state economy. The British started racial polarization through the system of divide and rule. Racial polarisation and disharmony continue due to the demonic practice of segregation by race.



- *Pray for deep healing of the land from wounds caused by racial divides, and breaking of the yoke of racism. Pray for strong, loving relationships, resolution of conflicts, and for Johor to be a model of racial harmony.*
- *Pray for righteous leaders with integrity, wisdom, and a heart for justice, who will exalt God's will and promote unity over division.*
- *Repent of divisiveness and individualism in the Church of Johor, that there will be unity, and oneness in the Body of Christ to become a reality. Pray for a spiritual awakening, a move of worship and prayer to saturate the state, and for believers to stand against darkness caused by idolatry, greed and corruption.*



DAY 9 (19 May 2026)

Redeeming the Land through Holy Living

Joshua 1:1–9 THE VOICE

³ *I will give you every place you walk, wherever your feet touch, just as I promised Moses.*

⁵ *No one will be able to oppose you for as long as you live. I will be with you just as I was with Moses, and I will never fail or abandon you....* ⁷ *Always be strong and courageous, and always live by all of the law I gave to my servant Moses, never turning from it—even ever so slightly—so that you may succeed wherever you go.* ⁸ *Let the words from the book of the law be always on your lips. Meditate on them day and night so that you may be careful to live by all that is written in it. If you do, as you make your way through this world, you will prosper and always find success.*

Devotion

God promised Joshua success in entering and claiming the promised land if he obeyed God and lived a life aligned to God's purpose and plan. When Joshua had a personal encounter with the Lord Jesus, the Captain of the Lord's army told him, "Take off your sandals. The ground where you are standing is holy!" (Joshua 5:15). This implies that God's holy presence releases transformative power that changes both the seen and unseen realms. The land itself absorbs the holiness of God!

So when we live right, when we practice purity and devotion, the land where we are dwelling in becomes restored. Ezekiel 36:33–36 provides a vivid picture of the reciprocal relationship between the people's conduct and the sanctity of the land.

³³ "This is what the Lord God says: On the day I cleanse you from all your iniquities, I will cause the cities to be inhabited, and the ruins will be rebuilt. ³⁴ The desolate land will be cultivated instead of lying desolate in the sight of everyone who passes by. ³⁵ They will say, "This land that was desolate has become like the garden of Eden. The cities that were once ruined, desolate, and demolished are now fortified and inhabited." Ezekiel 36:33–35 CSB

Righteousness exalts the land. A holy people attract divine blessings (Proverbs 14:34a).

Prayer Points:

- Pray that every believer will have a fresh encounter with a holy God. (1 Peter 1:16)
- Pray that we will put into practice the principles laid out in Psalm 15 for living right.
- Pray for the power of God to be manifested as His people live righteously – a shift in the atmosphere, captives set free and souls saved.

Pray for the State of Penang

Daniel 2:21-22

"He changes times and seasons; He deposes kings and raises up others. He gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to the discerning. ²² He reveals deep and hidden things; He knows what lies in darkness, and light dwells with Him.



Penang is known as the 'Pearl of the Orient', comprising of Penang Island and Penang Mainland. The state government's Vision 2030 is to be a 'Family-focused Green and Smart State that Inspires the Nation.

- *Pray for God to give wisdom to church leaders to build vibrant churches. Churches to be strong in prayer, praying for a spiritual revival and awakening. A healing anointing to be released within the church and for the community. Numerical and spiritual growth in all churches.*

- *We pray Christians will love You more and seek first Your Kingdom and righteousness. The people of God will not be distracted by the cares and temptations of this world. May they live for You and bring in the harvest of souls.*
- *Pray that God will demolish the dark historical roots which were established in the land from its early founding e.g. idolatry, freemasonry, addictions and gangsterism. Lord, cleanse the land and set it free that Penang can rise to its prophetic destiny.*



DAY 6-10 "REDEEMING THE LAND"

DAY 10 (20 May 2026)

Signs of a Redeemed Land

Leviticus 26:4–10 CSB

⁴I will give you rain at the right time, and the land will yield its produce, and the trees of the field will bear their fruit. ⁵Your threshing will continue until grape harvest, and the grape harvest will continue until sowing time; you will have plenty of food to eat and live securely in your land. ⁶I will give peace to the land, and you will lie down with nothing to frighten you. I will remove dangerous animals from the land, and no sword will pass through your land. ⁷You will pursue your enemies, and they will fall before you by the sword. ⁸Five of you will pursue a hundred, and a hundred of you will pursue ten thousand; your enemies will fall before you by the sword.

⁹"I will turn to you, make you fruitful and multiply you, and confirm My covenant with you. ¹⁰You will eat the old grain of the previous year and will clear out the old to make room for the new.

Devotion

God promised these blessings when the land is healed:

1. Ecological health (Leviticus 26:4)
2. Economic health (Leviticus 26:5)
3. Personal security (Leviticus 26:6a)

4. Civil security (Leviticus 26:6b)
5. International security (Leviticus 26:7 – 8a)
6. Honour and growth (Leviticus 26:9)
7. Innovation and creativity (Leviticus 26:10)

In order to see these transformations come to pass in our land, we, the ekklesia, have to commit ourselves to take up our covenantal responsibility to

- a) Be salt and light where we live (Matthew 5:13-16).*
- b) Practise social justice. Defend the oppressed and seek peace (Isaiah 58:6-12).*
- c) Persistently intercede for the land until change occurs (Isaiah 62:6-7).*

When we, the church of Jesus Christ, advance together in humility to redeem our land, surely God will fulfil His word spoken through Isaiah 41:18-20,

¹⁸ I will open up rivers for them on high plateaus! I will give them fountains of water in the valleys! In the deserts will be pools of water, and rivers fed by springs shall flow across the dry, parched ground. ¹⁹ I will plant trees—cedars, myrtle, olive trees, cypress, fir, and pine—on barren land. ²⁰ Everyone will see this miracle and understand that it is God who did it, Israel's Holy One. LB



Prayer Points:

- *Pray for God to raise up committed and dedicated intercessors who will pray till change happens. Luke 18:1*
- *Ask God for discernment to pray strategically over the land or place where you are at.*
- *Pray for the church to be more socially concerned – caring for the orphans and widows. James 1:27*

Pray for the State of Penang

Proverbs 29:4

“By justice a king gives a country stability, but those who are greedy for bribes tear it down.”



Darul Ehsan means the "Abode of Sincerity". The most populated state in Malaysia, it has the largest economy, the largest contributor to the national Gross Domestic Product



- *Thank God for an abundance of resources and strong infrastructure. God will continue to prosper the economy whose core sectors are commerce, agriculture, services and international manufacturing companies.*
- *There will be unity of purpose among the state governing parties. Godly men and women will arise to hold positions of authority. Wisdom for the present government and each parliamentary constituency and state constituency to be filled by God fearing and righteous men and women.*
- *We pray for a powerful unity of the body of Christ in Selangor so that the churches of Selangor will arise to carry out God's Mandate over this state. May every believer be bold in faith, gentle in speech, and steadfast in prayer. We pray for the Orang Asli, the Anak Sulung of the land to awaken and take their place as the firstborn of the land. They will redig the wells of revival.*



DAY 11 (21 May 2026)

The Promise of Power

Acts 1:4-8 NLT

⁴ Once when he was eating with them, he commanded them, “Do not leave Jerusalem until the Father sends you the gift he promised, as I told you before. ⁵ John baptized with^[b] water, but in just a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.”

⁶ So when the apostles were with Jesus, they kept asking him, “Lord, has the time come for you to free Israel and restore our kingdom?”

⁷ He replied, “The Father alone has the authority to set those dates and times, and they are not for you to know. ⁸ But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

Devotion

Before Jesus sent His disciples out, He knew they needed help; therefore, He told them to wait. Not only because they were unqualified, though they were, but because they were incomplete without the Holy Spirit. They had seen miracles, heard truths, and walked with Jesus, yet Jesus knew knowledge alone was not enough. They needed power from above.

The Holy Spirit is not a bonus for advanced believers; He is the promise for every believer. We are often so busy that we rush into ministry and responsibility without waiting on God's empowerment. The Holy Spirit is God's answer to our weakness, fear, and limitations. He empowers ordinary people to live extraordinary lives for God. When the Spirit comes, He transforms our fear into boldness, confusion into clarity, and weariness into strength. God never sends us without first empowering us. Before you move, learn to wait on His promise.

Prayer Points:

- *Thank God for the promise of the Holy Spirit*
- *Ask for a deeper hunger for God's power, not self-effort*
- *Pray for patience to wait on God's timing and empowerment*

Pray for the State of Kedah

Isaiah 60: 1-2

¹ *“Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord rises upon you.*

² *See, darkness covers the earth and thick darkness is over the peoples, but the Lord rises upon you and His glory appears over you.”*



Kedah is the most ancient in Malaysia with records dating back to the 5th Century. It was once a prosperous centre for traders in the early days, especially those from India and China. The “Safe Abode” is known as the “Rice Bowl of Malaysia”.

- *Pray for God’s favour for abundant rice harvest, improved farming practices and agricultural innovations.*

- *There will be strong security along the Thai/Malaysia Borders, especially against human trafficking/smuggling. Pray against rampant logging, rapid deforestation and massive flooding, high truancy, drug addiction.*
- *Pray for the church to be strengthened and equipped, walking in the ministry of reconciliation. The pastors, leaders & Christians to be united in prayer and equipped for spiritual battles, dismantle all evil schemes of the enemy. God to send in labourers to plant churches strategically. Resilience as they encounter religious restrictions.*

DAY 12 (22 May 2026)

The Filling with Power

Acts 2:1–4 NLT

On the day of Pentecost all the believers were meeting together in one place.

² Suddenly, there was a sound from heaven like the roaring of a mighty windstorm, and it filled the house where they were sitting. ³ Then, what looked like flames or tongues of fire appeared and settled on each of them. ⁴ And everyone present was filled with the Holy Spirit and began speaking in other languages, as the Holy Spirit gave them this ability.

Devotion

The day of Pentecost was not just a historical moment; it was a day of divine empowerment. The disciples were gathered in unity and expectation, and God responded by pouring out His Spirit. The Holy Spirit did not trickle in quietly; He came in tongues of fire. God never gives wearily.

When the Spirit comes, He fills what is empty and ignites what is dormant. This empowerment was not about emotional excitement; it was about divine transformation. Fearful disciples became bold witnesses. Silence turned into bold preaching. Meekness turned into passion.

Being filled with the Holy Spirit is not a one-time event, it is continuous. It flows from the posture of surrender. God fills those who make room. If we feel dry, exhausted, or spiritually empty, the answer is not striving harder but yielding deeper. When we open our hearts, the Holy Spirit fills us again and again, renewing our passion for more of God. Find Him today!

Prayer Points:

- *Ask the Holy Spirit to fill you anew*
 - *Surrender areas you have kept from God*
 - *Pray for fresh fire and renewed passion for God*

Pray for the State of Kelantan

Malachi 4:2-3

"² But for you who revere My name, the sun of righteousness will rise with healing in its rays. And you will go out and frolic like well-fed calves. ³ Then you will trample on the wicked; they will be ashes under the soles of your feet on the day when I act," says the Lord Almighty,"



Kelantan is translated as the “Land of Lightning”. An agricultural state with green paddy fields, rustic fishing villages and a number of beaches.

- We pray for effective flood management system and infrastructure solutions to protect the forest. Pray against social ills of high rates of drug addiction, divorce and unemployment, incest, ‘mat rempit’, poverty and superstitious beliefs.*
- There will be rural development and poverty alleviation. Rural areas will have sustainable economic development, access to clean water, healthcare, education and employment opportunities so that the young generation need not leave their hometown.*

- *Pray for pastors and full-time workers serving in this ministry to have perseverance and endurance. The Orang Asli will be fairly treated and believers to grow in Jesus and share the gospel to their community. There will be revival among the various tribes especially in the Gua Musang district. All citizens will be treated with dignity regardless of their faith.*

DAY 13 (23 May 2026)

Living in Power

Romans 8:14–17 NLT

¹⁴ For all who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God. ¹⁵ So you have not received a spirit that makes you fearful slaves. Instead, you received God's Spirit when He adopted you as His own children. Now we call Him, "Abba, Father." ¹⁶ For His Spirit joins with our spirit to affirm that we are God's children. ¹⁷ And since we are His children, we are His heirs. In fact, together with Christ we are heirs of God's glory. But if we are to share His glory, we must also share His suffering.

Devotion

The power of the Holy Spirit is not only for ministry moments; it is for daily living. The same Spirit who raised Jesus from the dead lives in us. That means we are not powerless against sin, fear, or old mindsets. The Holy Spirit empowers us to live changed lives. He strengthens us to say no to what once controlled us and yes to God's ways.

Living in power is not about our willpower, it is about the power of the Spirit in us. Many believers try to change by discipline alone and end up discouraged. But when we rely on the Holy Spirit, we can achieve lasting change.

The Spirit wants to renew our minds, soften our hearts, and produce a godly character in us. The Holy Spirit empowers us not just to do God's work, but to become more like Christ. A Spirit-empowered life is marked by transformation.

Prayer Points:

- *Thank God for the Spirit who lives within you.*
 - *Ask for power to overcome areas of weakness and struggle.*
 - *Pray to become more like Christ.*

Pray for the State of Negeri Sembilan

Jeremiah 29:7

"7 Also, seek the peace and prosperity of the city to which I have carried you into exile. Pray to the Lord for it, because if it prospers, you too will prosper."



"Land of Nine States," named for the nine historical Minangkabau chiefdoms.

- We pray for economic growth. Guidance upon the manufacturing sectors, agricultural activities and tourism industry. There will be good job opportunities and fair wages.*
- We pray that the universities and educational institutions will have a spirit of excellence. All communities will have equal access to quality education.*
- There will be spiritual breakthroughs. Uproot and overthrow the altars of traditional religions, false religions, cults, greed and sexual immorality.*

DAY 14 (24 May 2026)

Sharing the Power

Acts 4:32-35 NLT

³² All the believers were united in heart and mind. And they felt that what they owned was not their own, so they shared everything they had. ³³ The apostles testified powerfully to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and God's great blessing was upon them all. ³⁴ There were no needy people among them, because those who owned land or houses would sell them ³⁵ and bring the money to the apostles to give to those in need.

Devotion

The ultimate purpose of the Holy Spirit is to empower us to become a witness of His glory and goodness. When the disciples were filled with the Spirit they didn't just get along a bit better, but they started to share everything with each other. The Holy Spirit does not empower us to stay comfortable; He empowers us to be courageous. He gives us boldness to speak truth with love, to live out our faith publicly, and to represent Jesus faithfully. Becoming a true disciple is not about going to church but it is about a Spirit-filled life that points others to Christ.

When we are empowered by the Holy Spirit, our lives carry spiritual authority and authenticity. People may disagree with our opinions, but they cannot deny a transformed life. God is still filling His people today so that the world may see Jesus through us. The Holy Spirit empowers us to go, to speak, and to shine in a dark world.

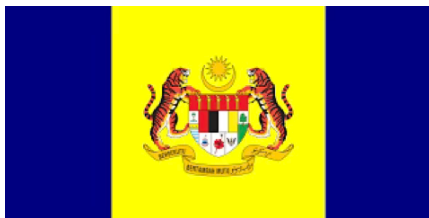

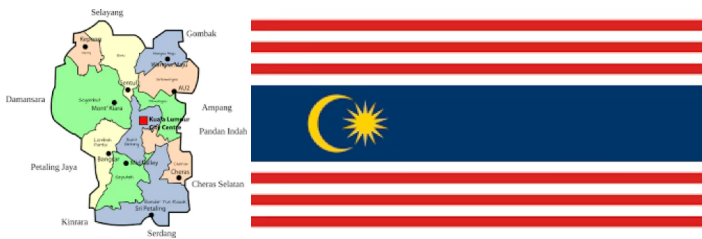
Putra means prince or son. Hence Putrajaya means "victorious men" or "victorious people. Putrajaya is the federal administrative centre of Malaysia and the seat of the federal government of Malaysia. Putrajaya is also a part of MSC Malaysia, a special economic zone that covers the Klang Valley.

- *Pray for the Prime Minister and the Cabinet Ministers and the Members of Parliament to be people of wisdom, integrity, and courage to govern justly and serve the people well.*
- *Pray for political stability and mature democratic processes that prioritise national interests over personal gain.*
- *Pray for Malaysia's economy - for wise fiscal policies, sustainable growth, and equitable wealth distribution.*

Kuala Lumpur

Malachi 4:2-3 (NKJV)

² "But to you who fear My name The Sun of Righteousness shall arise With healing in His wings; And you shall go out and grow fat like stall-fed calves. ³ You shall trample the wicked, for they shall be ashes under the soles of your feet on the day that I do this," Says the Lord of hosts.



Rated as an alpha world city, Kuala Lumpur is the cultural, financial and economic centre of Malaysia. Kuala Lumpur remains as Malaysia's national capital city per the constitution and is still the seat of the head of state (Yang di-Pertuan Agong) and the national legislature (Parliament of Malaysia).

- *Pray for healing of historical wounds from 1897 riot, 1912 tauchang (pigtail) riot and 13 May 1969 incident and the breaking down of racial divide and walls of prejudice and for racial and religious harmony. Pray for Christians to be agents of reconciliation, and for freedom of religion to be protected.*
- *Pray for right strategies to be implemented by the law enforcement to eradicate the social ills like crime, drugs, gambling etc. as well as high property values that have attracted corruption, leading to probes into land embezzlement and project approvals.*
- *Pray for God's wisdom, direction & guidance for YB Hannah Yeoh, serving as the Minister in the Prime Minister's Department in charge of the Federal Territories since 2025.*

Labuan

Ephesians 3:16-19

“¹⁶ I pray that out of His glorious riches He may strengthen you with power through His Spirit in your inner being, ¹⁷ so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, ¹⁸ may have power, together with all the Lord’s holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, ¹⁹ and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.”



The name Labuan derives from the Malay word labuhan, which means "harbour. Labuan is an international offshore financial centre as well as an offshore support hub for deepwater oil and gas activities in the region. It is also a tourist destination for people travelling through Sabah, nearby Bruneians, and scuba divers. Economically, it faces challenges from an over-reliance on oil & gas, reduced tax haven appeal (TRX competition), and fiscal imbalances despite high GDP, with calls for greater autonomy or reintegration with Sabah due to its unique challenges.

- *Pray for Labuan's main problems of inconsistent basic utilities (water, power) and weak infrastructure (transport links, internet) to be resolved.*
- *Pray for more allocation of funds for their basic infrastructure to alleviate poverty in the state.*
- *Pray for awakening among the believers of God - to be worshippers of God, grounded and rooted in the Word, and filled with the power of the Holy Spirit.*
